### 18 March 2019 – Cobb's Farmshop to Freeman's Marsh, Hungerford,

<b>Plants</b>	(in flower) common field speedwell, lesser celandine, daisy, red deadnettle, dandelion, ground ivy, hairy bittercress, white deadnettle, groundsel, early dog violet
<b>Trees/shrubs</b>	(in flower) - Italian alder, goat (pussy) willow, hazel, blackthorn
<b>Other</b>	<b>birds</b> – (seen or heard) – blackbird, magpies, gt spotted woodpecker, goldfinches, red kite, pheasant, robins, woodpigeon, blue tit, great tit, greenfinch, chaffinch, mallards, moorhen, song thrushes, chiffchaff, wren, hedge sparrows, crow, cormorant, mute swan, <b>insects</b> - buff tailed bumble bee <b>other</b> – squirrels various unidentified lichens and small fungi

### 9 April 2019 – Ramsbury

<b>Plants</b>	(in flower) – groundsel, dandelion, white deadnettle, daisy, hairy bittercress, green alkanet, greater periwinkle, annual meadow grass, red deadnettle, ivy-leaved speedwell, lesser celandine, thale cress, petit spurge, ground-ivy, marsh marigold, cow parsley, yellow archangel, redcurrant, dog's mercury, creeping comfrey, primrose, butterbur, hedge garlic, bluebell, wavy bittercress, common dog-violet, whitlowgrass
<b>Trees/shrubs</b>	(in flower) – blackthorn, ash, hawthorn, hazel, sycamore
<b>Other</b>	<b>birds</b> – (seen or heard) – blackbird, coal tit, robin, rook, mallard, house sparrow, greater spotted woodpecker, chiffchaff, woodpigeon, chaffinch, red kite, wren, pheasant, great tit, grey heron, crow, song thrush, moorhen, blue tit <b>insects</b> - buff tailed bumble bee <b>other</b> – bracket fungus

### 14 May 2019 – Ashbury (Ridgeway to Wayland's Smithy)

<b>Plants</b>	(in flower) – green alkanet, cow parsley, ground ivy, white deadnettle, sterile (barren) brome, goose grass, dandelion, sun spurge, buttercup, groundsel, black grass, fumitory, red campion, great forget-me-not, herb robert, spear thistle, stinging nettle, common vetch, daisy, ribwort plantain, germander speedwell, cowslip, wood avens (herb bennet), meadow buttercup, common mouse-ear, annual meadow grass
<b>Trees/shrubs</b>	(in flower) – hawthorn, horse chestnut, wayfaring, apple, spindle, field maple, blackthorn, elderflower
<b>Other</b>	<b>birds</b> – (seen or heard) – whitethroat, great tit, blue tit, woodpigeon, chaffinch, meadow pipit, buzzard, dunnock, blackbird, blackcap, chiffchaff, raven, robin, greenfinch <b>insects</b> - buff tailed bumble bee, ladybird, <b>butterflies</b> – peacock, orange tip, brimstone, small white, small blue, red admiral

### 11 June 2019 – Jones's Mill WWT Reserve, Pewsey

<b>Plants</b>	(in flower) – white clover, red clover, dandelion, hogweed, <b>dove's-foot crane's-bill</b> , goose grass (cleavers), hawk's-beard (common catsear), creeping buttercup, meadow buttercup, common sorrel, mouse-ear, lesser trefoil, yellow rattle, ribwort plantain, ox-eye daisy, cow parsley, red campion, stinging nettle, herb robert, wood avens, bramble, yellow flag iris, creeping thistle, purple vetch, self heal, <b>bog</b>

### 9 July 2019 – Shaw Forest Park, Swindon

<b>Plants</b>	<p><i>(in flower)</i> – bramble, stinging nettle, goose grass (cleavers), cut-leaved crane's-bill, creeping thistle, hogweed, beaked hawk's-beard, ground ivy, white clover, creeping buttercup, ribwort plantain, daisy, dandelion, creeping cinquefoil, black medick, tufted vetch, meadow vetchling, teasel, self heal, broad-leaved dock, ox-eye daisy, great bindweed, purple loosestrife, silverweed, red clover, meadow buttercup, common knapweed, common bird's-foot trefoil, field bindweed, ragwort, common melilot, bristly ox-tongue, mallow, hairy tare, hop trefoil, great willowherb, hedge woundwort, marsh woundwort</p>
<b>Trees/shrubs</b>	<p><i>(in flower)</i> – elderflower</p> <p>hazel nuts</p>
<b>Other</b>	<p><b>birds</b> – (<i>seen or heard</i>) – red kite, buzzard, rooks, song thrush, magpie, chaffinch, gull, greenfinch, blackbird, chiffchaff, woodpigeon, heron</p> <p><b>butterflies</b> – large white, meadow brown, marbled white, painted lady, orange tip, gatekeeper, black caterpillar</p> <p><b>insects</b> – blue dragonfly, green grasshopper, buff tailed bumblebees, honey bees, 6 spot ladybirds</p> <p>other – rabbit</p>

### 13 August 2019 – Knap Hill

<b>Plants</b>	<i>(in flower)</i> – silverweed, pineapple weed, white clover, meadow crane's-bill, knotgrass, stinging nettle, creeping thistle, hogweed, meadow buttercup, white deadnettle, bittersweet, rough hawkbit, smooth hawk's-beard, fairy flax, red bartsia, red clover, melilot, yarrow, black knapweed, greater knapweed, hedge bedstraw, wild basil, common agrimony, harebells, perforate St John's-wort (hypericum), bristly ox-tongue hawkweed, wild carrot, burnet saxifrage, rounded headed rampion, small scabious, meadow vetchling, rock rose, bird's-foot trefoil, black medick, nodding thistle, spiny rest harrow, common ragwort, ribwort plantain, dwarf thistle, self heal, daisy, ladies bedstraw, devil's-bit scabious, kidney vetch, hoary plantain, sain foin, common mouse-ear, saw-wort, clustered bellflower, squinancywort, common eyebright, dandelion, broad-leaved dock, shepherd's purse, felwort (Autumn gentian). <i>grasses</i> – Yorkshire fog, quaking, perennial rye
<b>Trees/shrubs</b>	<i>(berries)</i> – hawthorn, elderflower, rosehips, blackberries
<b>Other</b>	<b>birds</b> – <i>(seen or heard)</i> – carrion crows, rooks, meadow pipits, herring gull <b>butterflies</b> – large white, small white, meadow brown, common blue <b>insects</b> – grasshopper, buff tailed bumblebees, other bees, ladybirds <b>snails</b> – garden, white lipped, banded

### 10 September 2019 – Barbury Castle

<b>Plants</b>	<i>(in flower)</i> – ragwort, white deadnettle, prickly sowthistle, yarrow, dandelion, shepherd's purse, hogweed, stinging nettle, sainfoin, melilot, lucerne/alfalfa, perennial sowthistle, phacelia, knotgrass, white clover, autumn hawkbit, field poppy, nodding thistle, bush vetch, meadow vetchling, plantain, lady's bedstraw, smooth hawk's-beard, common mouse-ear, bird's foot trefoil, ribwort, wild carrot, meadow crane's-bill, tormentil (potentilla), red bartsia, rock rose, field scabious, black knapweed, wild thyme, harebell, devil's bit scabious, meadow buttercup, burnet saxifrage, autumn gentian (felwort), eyebright, self heal, rough hawkbit, stemless thistle, daisy, dove's-foot crane's-bill <i>(berries)</i> - bittersweet
<b>Trees/shrubs</b>	<i>(berries)</i> – Swedish whitebeam, Norwegian sycamore, buckthorn, field maple, hawthorn, wayfaring, elderberry, bramble <i>(flowers)</i> - cornus
<b>Other</b>	<b>birds</b> – <i>(seen or heard)</i> – swallows, house martins, wood pigeons, herring gulls, kestrel, red kite, crow, buzzard <b>butterflies</b> – large white, small white, small tortoiseshell, <b>insects</b> – grasshopper, garden bumblebee, other bees, 6 spot ladybird, crane fly, green beetle, day flying moths <b>fungi</b> – Marasimus oreades (the Fairy Ring Champignon), Conocybe
