### Report from our Coffee Exchange, Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023

'Crossing the Pond' is the expression, often used by pilots, to describe the route between the UK and the USA. The North Atlantic Ocean being the "pond". Mike Morison who has spent his whole career in aviation, including training civilian and Army pilots, gave us a thorough and detailed breakdown of the processes that commercial pilots need to undertake to ensure a safe and smooth journey for passengers. He showed us detailed plans of runways both in Heathrow and New York, weather charts, flight paths and alternate landing sites. Mike presented the intricate story of the flight and its possible twists and turns, in an entertaining way. We all hung on his words and the questions that were put to him showed how he had engaged us all in the journey.


### u3a in Kennet 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary tree planting

The Executive Committee agreed to plant a traditional Wiltshire variety of apple tree '**Chorister Boy**' in 2022 to commemorate the u3a in Kennet's 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The project was delayed to 2023 as our selected tree had not grown sufficiently large and took place eventually on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2023.

With expert advice from Phillipa Davenport of the Marlborough Community Orchard, and the Marlborough Town Council Estates Department team the tree is now in situ in the Jubilee Field at Manton.
