COPYRIGHT BRIEFING NOTE - September 2024

1. Definition.

Copyright is the right to copy intellectual property.

2. Ownership of copyright.

Only the creator of the work can authorize anyone to reproduce their work.

3. Intellectual property includes

Audiovisual works, such as TV shows, movies, and online videos.

- Sound recordings and musical compositions.
- Written works, such as lectures, articles, books, and musical compositions.
- Visual works, such as paintings, posters, and advertisements.
- 4. Breach of copyright may result in fines or imprisonment
- 5. u3a in Kennet has a limited right to copy

u3a in Kennet has a Copyright Licence Agency Licence which permits us to copy and use materials for educational purposes for our own members only.

Put simply:

- Many of our articles, photographs, and website items are subject to copyright.
 Do not, for example, allow our 'YouTube' films of our talks to be passed to non u3a members.
- Use photographs that you have taken (You own the IPR) if you can.
- If not use the Public Domain websites for copies or music. These have been granted freedom from being copyright.
- If you have doubts please seek advice from the Executive Committee.
