

Monday Walking Group – Schedule 01/07/26-30/09/26

Would leaders please ensure that emergency first aid equipment is carried by someone walking that day and that, should they be required for road walking, reflective vests are available.

- Bring own personal first aid requirements, e.g. sanitiser, sting relief, plasters, sun cream
- Carry details of your preferred emergency contact, written on a piece of paper and stored with your mobile phone so it easy for us to find in the event of an emergency
- Lunch - organised by the walk leader(s) at their discretion

No stiles unless anyone wants to visit the graveyard on top which is where we will take our break.

Park in nearest car park to Marlborough	A quiet circular walk to Little Bedwyn involving a narrow lane, tracks by woodland and Kennet & Avon canal. Gentle incline or level. No stiles but 28 steps up and over railway bridge and a level crossing over railway line. Poles might help. Lunch at pub afterwards possible. Please can someone bring a high viz jacket if possible!
Monday 20th July 10.30	Start at Ramsbury Recreation Centre, Hilddrop Lane A map showing the location of the start of the walk is on the last page of the schedule	Circular walk to take in the Seven Bridges footpath and back along the lanes for a view of Ramsbury Manor. A couple of short hills and patches of mud if it's wet and poles would be handy for the hills.
Monday 27th July 10.30	Roots Farm Shop Old Potato Yard Lydeaway SU 052 578	Around Urchfont on tracks, paths and lanes. No big hills and no stiles

SN8 1PN SU 1596 7001 What3Words ///object.thumb.flop https://maps.app.goo.gl/KU6uzi2fZLY6Qhjq9	Redpost Farm, down to Clatford&Fyfield. Return via Fyfield Down crossing A4 twice. Short stretch on country lanes nearClatford. No stiles.Long incline up Fyfield Hill
Monday 10th August 10.30	Redpost Farm car park Downs Lane, Marlborough. SN8 1PN (same as on 3 rd August)	Walk to Devils Den and the Valley of the Stones. Up and down a bit and one stile.
Monday 17th August 10.30	‘Phoenix’, Wootton Rivers. SN8 4NQ Parking for 10 cars	TBC
Monday 24th August 10.30	Parking the end of East Sands Road, Burbage	Walking to Marr Green, Southgrovecopse, Eastcourt No stiles. Flat
Monday 31st August 10.30	Bank holiday – no walk	
Monday 7th Sept 10.30	Old Pig Farm Minal SU 210 718 W3W: chain.certainly.rests	Circular walk via Bytham Farm, Blue Barn and Whiteshard Bottom.

Monday 14th Sept 10.30	Meet on Elcot Lane Marlborough at back of Roebuck	Circular walk to Mildenhall and back. Depending on the weather, there will be a steep climb at the beginning to get to the ridge. Then down and flat from then on. Beautiful views over Mildenhall and the past the church and back on old railway line and the nature reserve. 4 to 5 miles depending on route. Option to shorten if people want to.
Monday 21st Sept 10.30	Avebury NT car park SN8 1RD. (Free to members, but remember your card.)	Actual walk will depend on ground conditions, expect some uphill and downhill but no stiles. Good views.
Monday 28th Sept 10.30	Great Bedwyn Village Hall Frog Ln, Great Bedwyn, Marlborough SN8 3PD	Walk round Chisbury woods to and from Great Bedwyn. There are some hills.
